**Lodging:** The Cristiana Guest Haus, a cozy bed and breakfast lodge, conveniently located just one block north of Elk Avenue and the main business district, the lodge is a short walk to shops and restaurants and about 50 yards from the free shuttle to Crested Butte Mountain and to the Nordic ski center. The lodge also has a sauna, and high speed internet access. Each morning a generous continental breakfast is served featuring homemade granola, fresh fruit with yogurt, and a delicious selection of freshly baked pastries such as cinnamon rolls, croissants, homemade scones and muffins, along with juices, freshly ground coffee, a selection of Celestial Seasonings teas, hot chocolate and spiced cider. **During ski season freshly baked cookies are set out for a tempting apres ski treat!**
