Important Info

- **VERY IMPORTANT!** Skiers must have a passport that expires after **July 29, 2022**. It can take 3 months to renew your passport. Please ensure you are prepared for international travel, download the sign-up sheet, fill out your passport information and bring it with you to the corn roast. The sign-up sheet is available on the AASC web site
- **AND!** Skiers may be required to show **proof of Covid vaccination**, and possibly submit to a Covid test/sequestration as they travel over the border. Exact requirements continue to develop and are subject to change. **The AASC requires COVID-19 vaccinations to participate in ski trips.**
- Lift tickets purchased directly from EPIC are not refundable.
- **United Airlines will charge for baggage.** They have a baggage calculator online. Indicate in the calculator that yours is an economy flight from Detroit to Vancouver. You'll be able to pay online in advance of travel, or at check-in. Generally, the first bag is free, all others are checked for a fee, and boot bag plus skis count for one bag.
